What are we investigating?

The Veterinary Medical Center at the University of Minnesota is evaluating the efficacy of Aldara (imiquimod) on equine aural plaques. This is a topical medication that has recently shown to have very good efficacy in the treatment of sarcoids.

Why treat aural plaques with Aldara?

Aural plaques are caused by a virus and this topical medication has an excellent anti-viral effect.
