

Short-eared Owl Mask

Summary

Students will make their own short-eared owl mask.

Grade levels

Any

Time required

About 1 class period, 40 minutes

Setting

Classroom

Materials

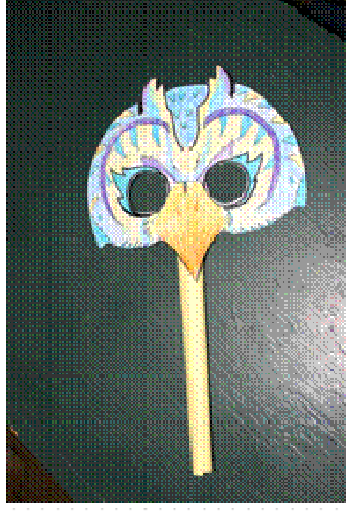
- One copy of owl mask for each student
- Markers or crayons
- Scissors
- Scotch tape
- Hole punch (use a hole punch smaller than 1/4" if possible)
- Yarn or elastic string

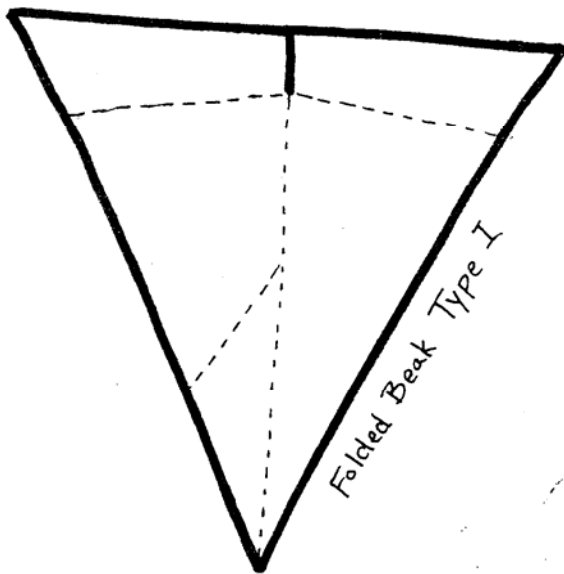
Procedure

1. Color mask.
2. Cut out mask and one beak.
3. Carefully cut out eye openings and notch in beak (solid line).
4. Fold beak (a mountain fold down the center, the rest valley folds) and attach to mask with scotch tape.
5. Put scotch tape over tabs for string attachment.
6. Punch holes in tabs on dot.
7. Knot string (yarn or elastic string) through each hole to proper head size.

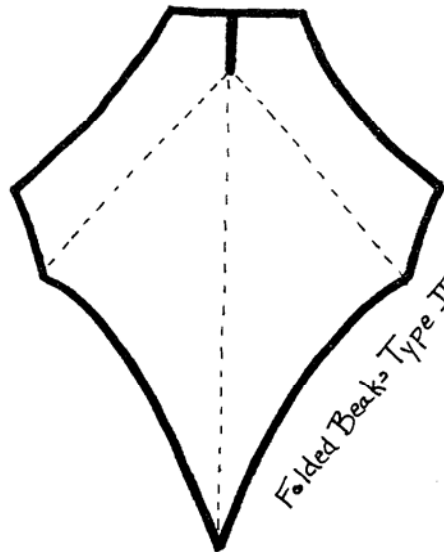
